Each year Kestrel offers grants for community initiatives, events and programs up to \$5,000 (however we will consider all applications).

Our Community Grants Program supports initiatives that create meaningful impacts in the areas we live and work. We're inviting local not-for-profit and community groups to apply for funding to bring their ideas to life. Whether you're focusing on health and wellbeing, education and opportunity, environment and sustainability, or community enhancements, we're here to help you make it happen.

We offer three application cycles annually, providing multiple opportunities for organisations to secure funding for their initiatives. We encourage successful applicants to reapply in future cycles, allowing them to continue building on their projects or bringing fresh ideas to life.



Whilst we are open to all community groups applying, we will not provide community investment support to organisations that are:

- For profit, without clear community connection.
- Discriminating on the basis of race, gender, ethnicity or lifestyle.
- Based around religious or political activities.
- Involved in advocacy or lobbying.
- Projects or programs that would ordinarily be fully funded
